








## The Bristol Stool Form Scale (Bristol Stool Chart)

<p><b>Type 1</b></p>		<p>Separate hard lumps, like nuts (hard to pass)</p>
<p><b>Type 2</b></p>		<p>Sausage-shaped but lumpy</p>
<p><b>Type 3</b></p>		<p>Like a sausage but with cracks on its surface</p>
<p><b>Type 4</b></p>		<p>Like a sausage or snake, smooth and soft</p>
<p><b>Type 5</b></p>		<p>Soft blobs with clear-cut edges (passed easily)</p>
<p><b>Type 6</b></p>		<p>Fluffy pieces, a mushy stool</p>
<p><b>Type 7</b></p>		<p>Watery, no solid pieces ENTIRELY LIQUID</p>

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
